Time and Place:

The bi-monthly meeting of the Appalachian Authors Guild was held on Tuesday, March 13, 2018 at Shoney's Restaurant in Abingdon, Virginia. The meeting took place from 11:30am – 1:30pm.

Call to Order:

The meeting was called to order by President Vicki Fletcher.

Business:

- ✓ A motion was made, seconded, and carried to accept the minutes of the board meeting on January 9, 2018, and the minutes of the board meeting on February 20, 2018, as distributed by secretary, Jami McDonald.
- ✓ The AAG has reserved 2 spaces at the Mistletoe Market, this year, Friday November 2nd Sunday November 4th. The Friday and Saturday timeslots are from 10 am 6 pm, and Sunday from 12 5 pm. The fee to reserve a space is \$50. You **do** have to be a paid member to reserve your space. If you are interested in this event, please mail your check (made out to AAG) and choices of days (please list 1st, 2nd, and 3rd) to Vicki at PO Box 222, Damascus, VA 24236. She **must** receive your space fee by May 1st. This is a highly trafficked event, so plan to have a successful turnaround for your fee. The AAG is also planning a fundraiser, soon, and if it goes well, we hope to reimburse members part of their Market sign-up fee.
- ✓ Membership dues for AAG are now being collected. Dues are \$30 and can be sent to AAG, PO Box 803 Abingdon, VA 24212. They can also be given to Vicki or Jack at AAG meetings. There is now a Paypal button on our AAG website that will allow you to pay your membership renewals/fees online. - ✓ We will have space at the Virginia Highlands Festival at Anthony's Desserts on Main Street. You must be a paid member to request space (or pay your dues and request space at the same time). Each paid member will be eligible to choose ONE participation day (12 - 6 pm with set up from 11 am to 12 pm). You can also choose to be there for either the 12-3 pm slot or the 3-6 pm slot. Please let Linda know your preferred day, time, if you would like to participate in the literary reading events, and if you have checked with another author about sharing your space. If you would like to donate \$5 or \$10, we plan to present Anthony with an honorarium for the use of his space. Please remember to be gracious to our host. He is giving us this space in his business without a fee, and seems excited to be partnering with us.
 - O Anthony's Desserts has also offered to provide us with shelf space to have our books displayed for sale (your presence isn't required). If you would like to have your books available for purchase, Vicki will try to arrange a time/way for your books to be present. You can also send Vicki your business cards or brochures to have available for the public to pick up during the festival. This is a great networking opportunity for our writers and their work!

Speaker:

Vicki Fletcher, President and Program Chair, introduced our first guest speakers, Russell and Ian Justice. Russell Justice spoke to us about a new website he is launching for authors/readers/publishers that will hopefully be ready for the public in April. Please check out the site and sign up for an account. The site is mybookspace.org. This is being offered to us FREE of charge.

Vicki Fletcher also introduced the second speaker, Dr. Grace Toney Edwards. Dr. Edwards is Professor Emerita of English and Appalachian Studies at Radford University. Retiring in 2010, she was the founding director of the Appalachian Regional Studies Center and chair of the interdisciplinary Appalachian Studies program. Her most recent book is *The Common Lot and Other Stories: The Published Short Fiction, 1908 – 1921, by Emma Bell Miles,* an anthology of short stories collected, edited, and introduced by Dr. Edwards, and published by Ohio University Press in 2016. She served as senior editor of *A Handbook to Appalachia: An Introduction to the Region* (2006), co-editor of the literature section of the *Encyclopedia of Appalachia* (2006), guest editor of the fall 2005 edition of *Appalachian Heritage*, featuring author Emma Bell Miles, and guest editor of the 2012 summer edition of *Appalachian Heritage*, focusing on author Breece D'J Pancake. Dr. Edwards's other publications include more than 100 book chapters, articles, essays, and reviews in journals and periodicals.

Dr. Edwards spoke to our group about her newest book and about the life of Appalachian author Emma Bell Miles. It was very informative and we appreciate her braving the snowy weather to come to speak to our group.
